For organisational and maximum social distancing reasons, if you wish to receive a delivery, the school may share your name and postal delivery address with the lunch supplier so that they can label your package for delivery by An Post. If you do not wish your address to be shared with the lunch supplier, the school can make arrangements for staff personnel to label your package and send it through An Post. If this is an option you wish to avail of, please specify this in your email.
