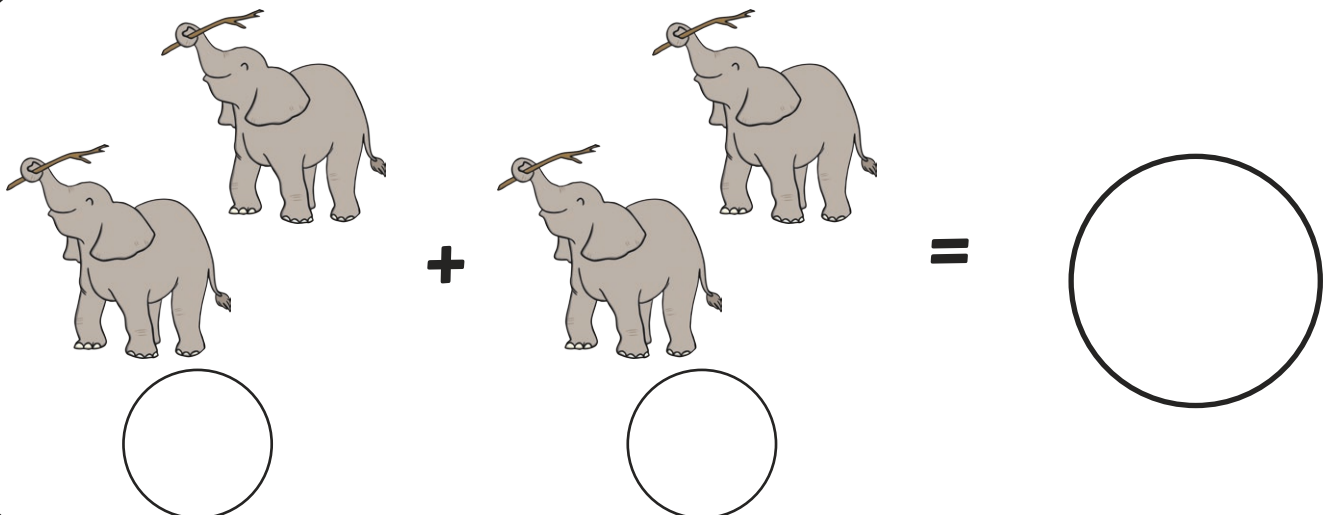
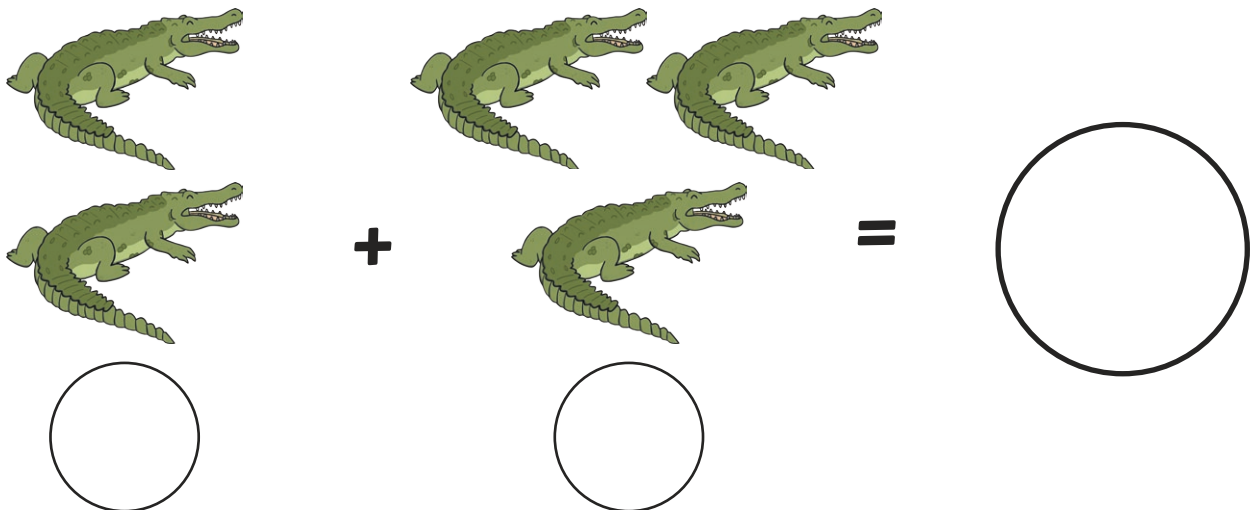
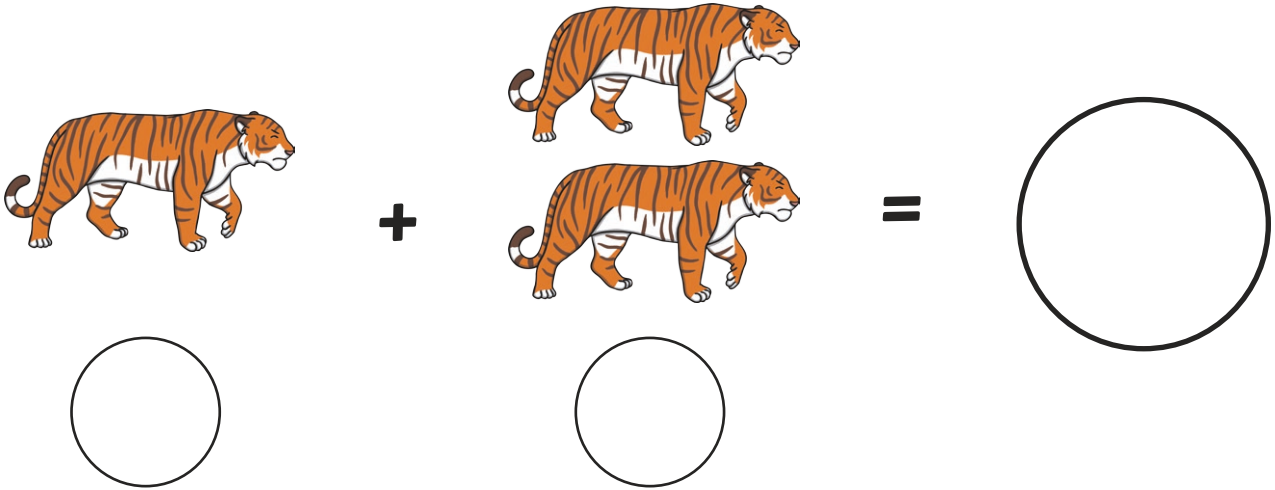




# Whos at the Zoo?

Count and write the amount of objects in each set. Then, add the sets together and write the answer in the space provided.


