Dear Parent/guardian,

I hope you and your family are well at this time? As you are aware, our school operates a school daily lunch under the School Meals Grant when children are in school. Using this grant, the Department of Education have instructed us to try and deliver food packages to the children that may wish to avail of them **once a fortnight**. These packages would include, for example, bread, fruit, pasta, cereal, tins of beans, etc. All children in the school can avail of this if they wish and where supplies and delivery allow.

**If you availed of these deliveries during the last school closure (March to June), we will presume you wish to again this time, unless you contact us to say otherwise.**

For organisational and maximum social distancing reasons, if you wish to receive a delivery, the school will share your name and postal delivery address with the lunch supplier and volunteer delivery persons so that they can organise delivery.
