

Home-Based Summer Programme to Support Children with Special Educational Needs 2021

12th May, 2021

Yesterday, the Department of Education announced that they will be making Home Based Provision for children with complex needs available over the summer, where a school based programme is not available. Greenmount N.S. is carrying out major electrical upgrade works in July and August so it will not be possible to run school based programmes. Therefore, parents who have a child that may qualify for the scheme will instead be able to source a tutor and the programme can be delivered at home.
